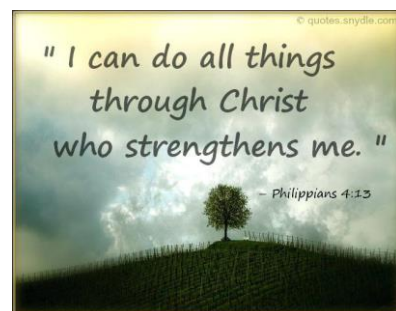
MONDAY FELLOWSHIP
